







THE EFFECT OF PICTURE MEDIA ON STUDENT'S ABILITY IN WRITING DESCRIPTIVE TEXT AT GRADE X OF SMK KESATUAN MERANTI IN ACADEMIC YEAR OF 2019/2020

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ABSTRAK

Because that, one of important point the teacher can should be an inspiration about their writing and become good supporter in writing learning process.

This researcher focused on the students' ability in writing descriptive text using picture. By this media, this researcher expects the students are able to write the example of descriptive text and also to complete their task about it. This researcher hope that pictures media can be a strategy which tries the students to build an active learning, joyfull learning and interesting learning teaching process especially in writing descriptive text.

Considering the background above, this researcher interested to done a study with title "The Effect of

Pictures Media on Students' Ability in Writing Descriptive Text. This researcher wants to conducted the research to find the effect of Pictures media on students' Ability in Writing Descriptive Text at Grade X of SMK KESATUAN Meranti in Academic Year of 2019/2020.

II. RESEARCH DESIGN Research Design

This research was conducted by using the experimental design. In this research there were two variables: Picture as independent variable and writing ability as dependent variable.

In conducting the experimental research, the sample be divided in two groups; the experimental group taught by using pictures and control group taught without using the pictures. Both of the groups will get pre-test and post-test with the same items.

Conclusions

Having analyzed and interpreted the data statistically, the conclusion could be conducted as following:

- Based on the average it can conclude that the students' ability in writing descriptive text in the post- test on the level good is 70.6%, but there was an effectiveness of the students in writing descriptive text used picture media between the score pre – test and the score post – test
- Based on the average it can conclude that the students' ability in writing descriptive text in the post – test on the level Moderate is 44.8%, because that, without using picture as media is not effectiveness in writing descriptive text for students.
- There is significant difference between the mean of control and experimental group. It means that using pictures in teaching writing descriptive text is more effective than teaching without pictures to enhance students' writing descriptive text.

Suggestions

Based on the conclusions above, it would be better to offer suggestions as the following:

- It is important to be teachers to teach writing descriptive text using pictures because they will help the teachers in teaching and helping the students understand what teachers want convey through the teaching material based on pictures.
- It is advisable to teachers of English to ask the students to practice writing descriptive text in English in developing their writing correctly.

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
